Permit to Discharge NH Permissible Fireworks

1. The applicant shall appear in person before the Fire Chief, or his Authorized Designee at least two days prior to the requested date of ignition.
2. The ignition is not allowed in the common path of approach by aircraft landing and taking off from Pease Air Base (refer to shaded area on attached map).
3. Fireworks shall not be ignited when aircraft is heard or visible to applicant. (Federal law prohibits the distraction or interference of pilots by the use of lighted projectiles or beam of light)
4. The flight ceiling for aircraft shall be over 1000 ft and 3 miles visibility at the time of ignition.
5. The firework display shall not exceed 100 ft from ground level.
6. The applicant shall provide proof that he, or she is the landowner of where the fireworks discharge is to occur, or has the Landowner's written permission.
7. The applicant shall provide a valid photo identification.
8. The applicant shall be at least 21 years of age or older, (NH RSA 160-C:11)
9. Fireworks shall be purchased from licensed Permissible Fireworks retailers in New Hampshire only. (Copy of Receipt for permit)
10. The applicant shall only purchase the quantity of fireworks needed for the permitted display. The storage of Permissible fire works is prohibited
11. Fireworks shall only be ignited on Saturday, Sunday or Federal Holidays.
12. Fireworks shall not be ignited by minors (anyone under the age of 21).
13. Fireworks shall be ignited a minimum of 100 feet from any structure or overhead utilities.
14. Fireworks shall only be displayed over the permittee's property.
15. The applicant is required to have a means of fire extinguishment readily accessible.
16. The permit shall only be valid for the date issued.
17. Applicant shall call the Fire Department 30 minutes prior to ignition.
18. Anyone discharging or igniting fireworks shall not be under the influence of any drugs or alcohol.
19. Permissible Fireworks shall only be discharged between the hours of 10:00 AM and 10:00 PM.
20. Permits will only be issued on days when the Fire Danger day is a Class One (low) or Two (moderate) as determined by the New Hampshire Division of Forest and Lands - Bureau of Forest Protection.

Failure to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall result in:

- a) First Offense: \$50 fine and revocation of permit,
- b) Second Offense: Up to \$1,000 fine and revocation of permit. Per Town Ordinance 15-01 Persons found guilty of a second offense will be prohibited from obtaining any further Permissible Fireworks Permits.
